Since 1885, Christ Episcopal Church has been growing to meet the needs of the parish and community of Eagle Lake. Through the generosity of those before us, we rebuilt from the tornado of 1900 and rose from the ashes after a fire destroyed the building in 1925.



As Christ Church approaches it's 135<sup>th</sup> birthday, she and the rectory are in need of some care. This historic building is our foundation. After a remodel more than half a century ago, some systems have simply worn out and the needs of the parish and community continue to evolve.

The list is long, the need is great.

Through prayerful consideration, and with parish input, the Vestry has determined to initiate the projects in the following sequence.

## First Crop - \$80,000

- ❖ A/C for Rectory & Church
- > Wiring in Church & Parish Hall
- > New Carpeting in Sanctuary
- > Complete the AV system

## **Second Crop - \$80,000**

- Replace Rectory Windows
- > Wheelchair accessibility throughout the Church and Parish Hall
- Parish Hall Kitchen updated
- > Irrigation for Church & Rectory lawns
- > Replace the Rectory deck

## **Bonus Crop**

Funds in excess of the actual cost of the projects in the First and Second tiers will be reserved and invested for future replacement, repair, and improvements of the church property.
